

Classroom Birthday

A few days ahead of celebrating a birthday at school, please give us details and one photo of what milestones/special events that happened each year of your child's life, beginning with birth. On the day of celebration, we have a special class time tradition where the birthday child holds a model of the earth and chooses a friend to represent the sun. The birthday child will walk around the sun once, then stopping so a teacher can explain what happened during that year of their life. He will walk around the sun again and stop so everyone can see and hear what happened that year. This continues until the child reaches his current age and the teacher will ask the child what milestones/special events happened recently. We ask that parents refrain from bringing a sugary treat on birthdays, which have a negative effect on work times and concentration. In lieu of treats, parents are welcome to donate a book to the class which the teacher will read on the child's celebration day.
