

Classroom Birthday

We want to make your child feel special on their birthday! We have a wonderful celebration that we share with all of our birthday students, but we need your help! A few days ahead of celebrating a birthday please create a small poster with one photo of your child each year of his/her life beginning with a newborn picture. Describe below what milestones/special events that happened each year of your child's life, beginning with birth. On the day of celebration, we have a special class time tradition where the birthday child holds a model of the earth and will walk around our classroom 'sun', stopping each full rotation so the teacher can explain what happened during that year of their life. He/She will walk around the sun again and stop so everyone can see and hear what happened that year. This continues until the child reaches his current age and the teacher will ask the child what milestones/special events happened recently. Parents are welcome to come celebrate with us! Please arrange the pizza order and/or delivery on your own. The pizza needs to be here by 11:15am. Remember to include tip if you wish.
